<b>Progress Milestones and 2020 Target</b>	85% of monitored PS beaches meet enterococcus standard, <sup>1, 2</sup> for previous two consecutive years. <sup>3</sup>	90% of monitored PS beaches meet enterococcus standard for previous two consecutive years.	95% of monitored PS beaches meet enterococcus standard for previous two consecutive years.	By 2020, all monitored Puget Sound beaches meet enterococcus standard. <sup>4</sup>
